What I need to know before my IUD placement

1. Why does the IUD procedure sometimes feel painful?

Traditionally, doctors use an instrument called tenaculum to hold the cervix steady. Most describe the sensation from this tool as a sharp pinch, which can also cause pain and bleeding.

2. What is carevix[®]?
